Scholarly Manuscripts: The journal welcomes contributions pertaining to the geography of the Western Interior or research produced by geographers located in the Prairie region. Particularly encouraged are scholarly papers presented at the 2019 Meeting of the Prairie Division of the Canadian Association of Geographers held at Saskatchewan Polytechnic, Moose Jaw. All scholarly submissions are peer-reviewed.

Occasional Reviews: The journal also welcomes review essays, viewpoints, dialogues, photo essays, field trip guides, and occasional notes of interest to its readership. Where appropriate, these entries are also peer-reviewed.
